

Adult citizens of the Republic of Serbia will receive an additional 20 euros in December, the Minister of Finance Sinica Mali announced today.

As he explained, that means that pensioners will receive a total of another 100 euros from the state by the end of the year, and other adult citizens will receive 50 euros each.

- Namely, pensioners will receive 50 euros in September, then 30 euros in November, and then 20 euros in December. Other adult citizens will receive 30 euros in November, for which they applied in May, and then 20 euros in December. Thanks to the responsible economic policy and the results achieved in the previous period, when Serbia achieved one of the best results in Europe when it comes to the rate of economic growth, we have enough funds for this new type of support to citizens.
